

BAWA – minutes June 10, 2019

Meeting was called to order at 7:12--05 pm

Treasurer's Report. There is \$32,507 in the Money Market and \$37,638 in the checking account at this time

Dave Jones updated us on Grizzly Duals. There are 12 schools total signed up, 9 total teams. Some schools have combined to form teams. So far only one check has been received. The others have said that they would bring their checks.

Wrestling will start at 9:00 am Saturday. Mat move will be on Thursday night.

Boyertown wrestlers will be credited \$100 for camp if they go to Arsenal.

East & West both need warm ups and West needs new singlets. Nick said he will negotiate getting money to help with gear and asked if BAWA would be able to help

Janine will get a list of sponsors to Stacey so she can post them on Facebook periodically as a way to promote their businesses and thank them for their support.

Virginia Beach Duals went well as far as the hotel arrangements are concerned. We used 8 of the 15 rooms we reserved. Tracey allowed another team to use the other 7 rooms we have reserved.

There was a discussion about a coaching decision made at the last-minute regarding weight classes for VB Duals. Some people were not happy about the way it was handled. We discussed creating guidelines (By-laws) for expectations for coaches to prevent issues arising and to take responsibilities off Kurt and Tracey's shoulders. Some events could be better organized.

Arsenal grew this past year, there are 10-12 different schools represented. Berks Catholic is doing a camp at the same time as Arsenal camp. There are approximately 135 wrestlers registered for camp, 89 elementary and 46 others.

There was a broken window at the ambulance building.

Wendy will get the Script Gift Card fundraising information together to roll out in the fall. We will be doing a Dairy Queen fundraiser the week after Grizzly Duals and Arsenal camp. We will be handing out flyers at both. We are going to try to get people together to sign up for volunteering and possibly become Board members via a social at Sassamansville in the fall. Wendy informed everyone that she is going to be needing help with Bear Duals concessions as she is going to be needing knee replacement surgery in the not too distant future.

Fun Days went well. We had 12 high school, 2 middle school and several youth wrestlers help out. Parents signed up way ahead of time and coaches were also present. Dave met with the kids to help get them involved. Thank you for that. We raised over \$3,000.00 in 2 days. We must pay the Park \$450.00.

We discussed the possibility of paying a stipend to coaches at the Middle School and High School levels.

The ambulance was grateful for the \$100 donation we made toward their Community Day event.

Mark Fluharty added transportation to and from events at a cost of \$150.00 per year to our insurance policy.
